Main Responsibilities

- Hiring assistant coaches.

- Recruiting, including developing and maintaining an active recruitment plan for current and future needs.
- Supervising of all student athletes on Crandall-related travel and adherence to the Athletes Code of Conduct.
- Contributing to the promotion and development of volleyball in the greater Moncton area and the surrounding communities of southern New Brunswick.
- Coordinating summer volleyball camps.
- Coordinating and collaborating with fundraising activities specific to the program and the department.
- Establishing and maintaining an effective communication system with athletics administration, facility staff, faculty, fellow coaches and student athletes.
