

Coach Responsibilities

The coaches' responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Working in cooperation with the HP committees' vision and the mentor coaches
- Make recommendations on the design and implementation of tryouts
- Input on the selection of athletes to represent Team NB
- Development of a training plan for the summer in conjunction with Volleyball NB
- Implementation of the training plan
- The training and development of all the athletes selected to their teams or training group
- Preparing the athletes and teams for competition
- Working with the Mentor Coaches to align training wih the VNB skills document, and program goals.
- Coaches have a responsibility to: attend tournament coaches' meetings, ensure that all obligations as they relate to their team at competition are fulfilled, and operate their team within the rules of the game and the rules of fair play.

Coach Behaviour

- Coaches are to abide by and enforce VNB's policies on: Athlete Protection,
 Abuse, Code of Conduct and Ethics, Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, Safe Sport,
 and Harassment.
- Coaches are expected to behave in a responsible and professional manner at all times, recognizing their influence upon athletes and members of the volleyball community.
- Coaches have a responsibility to supervise/chaperone their athletes during any and all provincial team functions (e.g. It is expected that curfews be set and monitored by the coaches).
- Alcohol is prohibited during scheduled athlete supervision. Drug use is prohibited.



- Coaches have the authority and responsibility to deal with minor athlete behavioural issues in a manner befitting the offence.

Coach Development Opportunities

As part of Team NB training, mentor coaches will work with the coaching staff. Mentors will be on-site during training and available for discussion in downtime. Mentoring sessions will be planned in the summer schedule. If a coach is interested in having a mentor coach run a session for their team, please advise the mentor coach or VNB Director of Operations.

Coach Certification

All coaches must submit a valid criminal record and vulnerable sector check, and have completed Coaches Association of Canada Safe Sport Training. Coaches must also complete a screening form.

All coaches must minimally have the following NCCP coaching qualifications:

- Foundations of Volleyball (VC Coaching Centre)
- Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation (Locker)
- Making Head Way- Generic Version (Locker)

Desired NCCP Coach Certifications are as follows:

14U Head Coach – Minimum of Development Coach certified
15U Head Coach – Minimum of Advanced Development Coach certified
17U Head Coach – Minimum of Advanced Development Coach certified
14U, 15U, 17U Assistant Coaches – Minimum of Development Coach in training.



Coach Compensation

Honorariums will be provided following the completion of the full coaching commitment. No partial honorariums will be paid to coaches who leave their positions before the program ends.
